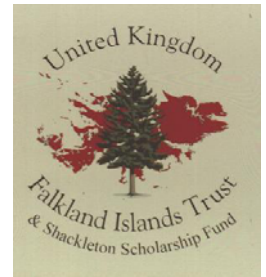

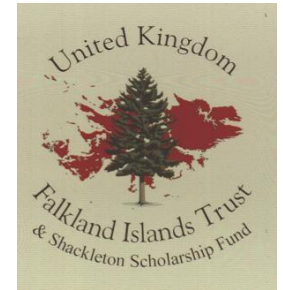

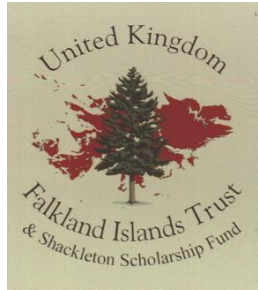

## What Can UMAG offer to the Falkland Islands

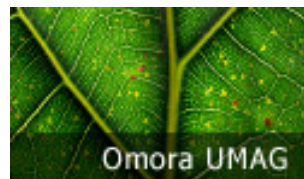
- Participation of students in Undergraduate & Master courses

- Research Collaboration (Existing QUB/UMAG Model)



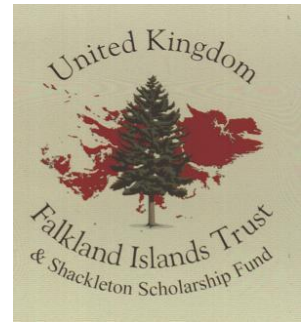
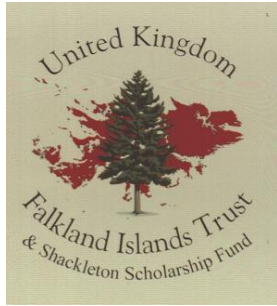

- Lobbied for and arranged this visit





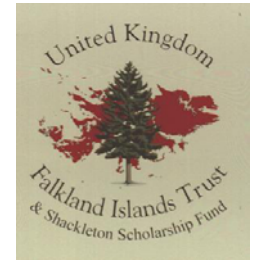
